George⁶, was administrator, and in his account charges for three years and three months' labor. He was of Middleboro. The Court ordered that George have the real estate, except dower to widow, Phebe, paying out residue to the other heirs, viz., Gershom, Joseph, Ezra, Phebe, Mehitable and Mary.

343. (COLONEL) BARZILLAI RICHMOND⁵ (William⁴, Silvester³, Edward², John¹) was born in Little Compton, R. I., April 13, 1721, and died January 5, 1796. He married in Providence, November 24, 1743, Sarah, daughter of Ebenezer and Elizabeth Knight, who was born November 21, 1718, and died October 10, 1791.

The following is taken from the tombstone of Colonel Barzillia:

“In Memory of
Col. Barzillia Richmond,
who having served his country
for many years
in several public stations,
Departed this Life, on the 5th
Day of Jan’y, A. D. 1796,
Aged 74 years, eight
Months & 23 days.”

He was one of the seceders from the First Congregational Church on account of Josiah Cotton preaching “damnable good works.” The secession was in 1743, and he was one of the small number who formed the Beneficent Congregational Society.

He was in the Canada War during two campaigns, and in 1755, and afterwards was ordered to raise a body of men and proceed to the relief of the British Colonial Army on Lake Champlain. He contracted a disease in one of his legs which made him lame for life. He was at the siege of Ticonderoga under Dalrymple, a Colonel; he was not however, in the storming party. He brother William, of Little Compton, was with him as volunteer lieutenant.

At one time he received orders late Saturday night. He repaired to his minsters, and had an appropriate sermon preached on Sunday morning; opened a rendezvous for enlistment in the afternoon, and in the evening, with a large company, was on his march.

Of the four companies to be raised as a reinforcement to go against Crown Point under Major- General Johnson, he was a captain on the fourth company, and was Lieutenant-Colonel in 1758 and 1760. He also held various municipal, civil, and State office. He was a member of the General Assembly of Rhode Island in 1758, May and October, two sessions, and was also member of the Town Council of Providence.

Richmond Street, in Providence, received its name from Colonel Richmond, who with others, laid in out over what was then called Cow-pen Point to Ship Street. It has been extended since.

He had no children, and gave his property to his nephew, William Richmond⁶, second son of Sylvester Richmond⁵.

At the convention of the Governor's Council, as supreme ordinary of the English colony of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations at Newport, may, 1760, William Richmond, Esq., was one of ten Assistants of Gov. Stephen Hopkins. He was one of the Representatives of the town in 1779; was First Deputy in 1780, '81, '88, '90, '93; Moderator of Town Meeting in 1777, '82, '83, '86, '87, '88 and '91; and on the Committee of Safety for the County of Newport. He served in one or two campaigns in the Canada War, as Lieutenant under his brother, Col. Barzillai; was Lieutenant of a company sent against Crown Point in 1755, and Captain in Col. Champlin's regiment in 1756. He has a command as Colonel in the Revolutionary War, and was Colonel of the State Brigade in 1776; was Military Governor of Newport at one time during the War. He went on a military expedition to Long Island. The British has penetrated to the east part of the Island, and he went, with a detachment of soldiers, from the Connecticut shore, and dispersed them. Col. William Richmond and Gen. Barton, who surprised and took Prescott prisoner, were on terms of closest intimacy. The General was accustomed to spend a part of the summer with Col. Richmond.

The Richmond freed their slaves before the Revolution, and settled them in Dartmouth Woods. The Richmond Farm, owned and occupied by Col. William Richmond, lies north of the farm now owned by Frederic Brownell, Esq. (which was formerly the property of Judge Perez Richmond), and extends for the road to the Seaconnet River. Here Capt. Edward Richmond

(first of the name) settled, died and was buried. His tombstone is still visible in the old family burying-ground. This farm was in the possession of the family continuously until within a few years. Rev. William Richmond of New York bought two and a half acres of land of Primus Collins, given to him by Col. Richmond, tore the old house down, and made the Richmond Farm complete as it was in the beginning before the Colonel's gift to Collins.

There is a noted and historical place on the farm called Awashonks' Rock, or Treaty Rock (named after Awashonks, the Queen Sachem of the Seaconnet Indians), where Col. Benjamin Church made his treaty with the Awashonks in King Philip's War. It was through his means and negotiations that the Indians of Seaconnet were induced to break off their alliance with the Sachem of Mount Hope.*

The following is the inscription upon the tombstone in the old family burial place, located near the house:

"Col., William Richmond, who having served his
county in several public stations for many
years, departed this life Sept. 23, 1807,
81 years of age."

Col. Richmond was a large man, with very white hair in his old age. He was a gentleman of the old school, but jocose, liberal, and greatly loved by his family and kindred. He was wealthy, for the times, and one of the first men in the town, very active and public-spirited in all its affairs. Many anecdotes are told of him, and his slaves, of which the following may be interesting:

Once, in high party times, Col. Richmond was told by the presiding officer that his vote would be taken out of the ballot-box (though well known since boyhood to every man in the town), because he had not registered his name; the Colonel replied, "If you touch my vote, I shall come down with this cane on your head," at the same time holding the vote in his left hand and the rebellious cane in the right hand. The officer attempted to extract the vote, and the cane came down and hindered the operation. A row ensued, in the mist of which an unexpected combatant appeared. Primus Collins, who had been honored with election to the negro governorship of Rhode Island (an ancient custom in that State), and who was always called Governor Collins, was in the galley. The white of his eyes and of his teeth were soon visible, and exclaiming, "It is about time for this darkey to drop," he leaped from the galley into the midst of the combatants, and by means of his black face, sudden appearance, and vigorous blows, scattered the opponents of "Old Master" right and left, and the vote remained undisturbed.

Primus Collins has been a slave of the Colonel, and was subject to twenty-five years' service, but liberated him and afterwards gave him a farm. Then he became a free voter, by the ownership of land. Col. Richmond took him to the polls and told him to put in his vote. The moderator forbade it, and said he had no right. Col. Richmond drew up his cane, and with a loud voice declared, "That *man* shall vote"; and he became a voter until his death. Afterwards, however, Isaac Wilbour (who was Chief-Justice and Member of Congress) of Little Compton,

got word “white” inserted in the statute respecting voting. Col. Richmond had another slave named Saul, who had the entire supervision and control of the farm. He found a negro woman and bought her, and had Saul marry her. They had children, one of whom he gave to Rev. Mace Shepherd, his minister, and other to some of his friends. One was named Jeffries, in derision of the Chief-Justice of England. Saul was complete master of ceremonies and affairs about the farm. An ox could not be bought without his presence and counsel. Mr. Shaw, a member of the Senate of Rhode Island from Little Compton, said of the Richmonds in Little Compton, “D---d proud family; they esteem their negroes better than common folks.

The Colonel was an ardent patriot and Revolutionist. He resided at one time, about the commencement of the Revolutionary struggle, at the house of his brother Barzillai in Providence, who was a good Deacon, but timid and peace-loving, if he did not in his heart sympathize with the Tories. The good man had family worship regularly every morning. Three days passed. The following morning the Deacon, as usual, had read the Scripture and was rising in order to pray, when the Colonel caught up his famous and trusty cane, and raising it above his head, exclaimed, “Stop!” and added, I have been here now three days, and every morning you have prayed and haven’t mentioned the American Congress, nor prayed for the success of the American arms. Now by G-d, if you don’t this morning, I’ll knock you down with the cane when you say ‘Amen’.” It is said the Colonel was not religious, -- but he certainly believed in the efficacy of prayer and his patriotism was beyond doubt.

Primus Collins lived in Little Compton many years, and died February 7, 1858, aged eight-one years. He was esteemed, and was a worthy and pious man. His daughter married Charles Simmons, and lived at one time at the head of Middle Street, New Bedford, Mass.

347. (JUDGE) PEREZ RICHMOND⁵ (William⁴, Silvester³, Edward², John¹) was born in Little Compton, R. I., October 13, 1728-9, and died November 23, 1800-1. He married, February 3, 1754, Mercy, daughter of Thomas and Edith (Woodman) Church, who was born September 18, 1734, and died October 24, 1813.

He was appointed to enlist minute-men, in Little Compton, June, 1775. He held various offices in town, and was a leading and influential man; was Auditor of town accounts; was Moderator of town meeting in 1784, ’85, ’89, ’90, ’93, and ’94; also Judge of Probate Court, and President of Town Council. He was a mild old gentleman, fond of children, and popular. He lived fifty or sixty years opposite the head of Meeting-House Lane, the place now owned by Fred. R. Brownell, Esq. (1895).

He was quartermaster and enlisting officer for Little Compton in 1759, and was one of a committee “who shall use diligence to procure arms and accoutrements” in 1776. He was killed by falling from his horse.

Perez Richmond⁵ and Mercy, his wife (with others), of Little Compton, R. I., conveyed, March 29, 1770, to Abraham Lincoln of Scituate, their interest in some land belonging to the estate of Thomas Church, who mentions Mercy Richmond in his will.

His will, dated November 3, 1800, probated February 4, 1801, mentions wife Mercy; sons Thomas and Charles; daughters Sarah Clapp, Ruth Gunnison, Elizabeth Hathaway, Anna Attwood, Mary Coddington, and Hannah Ellis; esteemed friend Mace Shepard; executors, Brother William and esteemed friend, Sylvester Brownell. He devised his real estate to his sons, and they sold out to Sylvester Brownell, the grandfather of Sylvester Richmond Brownell.

Perez Richmond⁵ and Mercy, his wife, William Bailey, Samuel Bailey, Francis Bailey, Ruth Bailey, and Sarah Wilbur, all of Little Church, by deed, dated March 29, 1770, witnessed by Thomas Church and William Richmond, and acknowledged March 30, 1770, before William Richmond, Justice of the Peace, conveyed to Abraham Lincoln, Scituate, land in Hingham; deed recorded August 6, 1773, book 124, p. 119.

348. (DR.) ICHABOD RICHMOND⁵ (William⁴, Silvester³, Edward², John¹) was born in Little Compton, R. I., October 18, 1731. He married, first, Martha -----; secondly, November 15, 1753, Mary Vunis of Bristol, R. I., daughter of Paul Vunis; thirdly, Abigail Ford (banns published July 30, 1757). He died in the East Indies.

He was a physician and surgeon and lived in Bristol. There is some uncertainty about dates of his marriages. Mary Vunis was of French origin and lived in Bristol, R. I.

I., December 26, 1735, and married, first, Dr. George Ware, son of William and Anna (Hodges) Ware, who was born August 26, 1734, and died February 16, 1771. Mary Richmond⁵ was of Dighton when the bans were published of her marriage to Thomas Church, who removed to Dighton; his son Gamaliel lived there at what is called the Church place. They went to Genesee, N.Y., and were the first white family in Ontario Co. They removed, about 1790, to what the Indians called Honega Flats, now the town of Richmond. He was concerned in several townships, and came East to raise money. He "used to exhort and pray for an hour when saying grace." He was captain of the "minute-men" at the commencement of the Revolution.

359. (COL.) EZRA RICHMOND⁵ (Sylvester⁴, Silvester³, Edward², John¹) was born in Little Compton, R. I., January 26, 1721. He married, first, February 18, 1751, Mary Baylies, daughter of Thomas and Esther (Sargent) Baylies of Warwick County, England, who was born in 1723, and died September 10, 1795. He married secondly, in 1796, Hannah Bosworth of Rehoboth, who died in Rehoboth in 1806. He died September 15, 1800.

He was a Colonel, and served in the French and Indian War with his father. He was in the British Army, and attained the rank of Captain, being the oldest Captain in the British line. He sold out his priority for a large sum. He was Representative from Dighton in the General Court in 1752, '53, and '54, and in 1765, '66, '67, and Town Treasurer in 1767. He was very wealthy for the times, having a great deal of ready money. He is said to have given the Baylies family an aristocratic influence in the town. He was strong-minded, resolute and influential, and some of his descendants mention the big wig he wore, and his aristocratic bearing. He received a commission from King George II in person in England, on account of his father's and his own services at Louisburg. He always wore a cocked hat and silver buckles.

His wife was a charming English lady, sister of Nicholas Baylies.

The following reference to Col. Ezra Richmond⁵ is from the "History of Bristol County": "He was a justice of the peace, and filled several responsible civil offices, and was a man of considerable influence. He lived in a house built by Jared Talbut, opposite the old meeting house."

He died July 11, 1797.

He was Major and Lieutenant-Colonel in the Revolution. We went to Rhode Island July 22, 1780, in Col. Hathaway's regiment, with Ezra, and again, December 8, 1776, in Col. Pope's regiment. He was Moderator of town meetings in 1767 and Selectman about ten years, 1767-77. His estate, appraised in 1797, was value at £4,863. March 5, 1775, he signed a receipt to his uncle, Perez Richmond (who was executor of his father's will), for a "silver sword which my honored grandfather gave me."

November 7, 1797, Widow Abigail Richmond was appointed guardian of her son Sylvester⁶, on account of his incapacity. Sylvester⁶, fell from a cherry-tree and received injuries which affected his mind.

Lieut.-Col. Sylvester Richmond died without making a will, and his widow, Abigail, applied to the Judge of Probate to have William Baylies appointed administrator. The division of a real and personal estate was made among the children in 1798, and the wife received her third.

The daughters, Sarah⁶ and Nancy⁶, lived at the old homestead in Dighton many years. Their beautiful garden abounded in lovely flowers and luscious fruit, which were a great temptation to the boys of the neighborhood, and caused many a war of words. The urchins called Sarah "Old Sale-ratus"; and the positive orders of Nancy were referred to as the edicts of Nantes. The sisters removed to Providence, R. I., and died there.

1121. JANE ANDREWS⁶, born Aug 1, 1755; married, March 1, 1772, Samuel Norton, who descended from Rev. John Norton of Hingham. We was nephew of Rev. John Norton of Ipswich and Boston, whose genealogy can be trace distinctly to the time of William the Conqueror. They had the following children, viz:
(1) (Rev.) JOHN NORTON⁷: was for forty-two years pastor if the First Religious Society in Newburyport. He was born March 3, 1774, and died Aug. 17, 1845.
(2) JANE NORTON⁷: married *Thomas Wigglesworth* of Boston, who was born in 1776, and died April 27, 1855. He was one of the oldest and wealthiest merchants of the city, and one of the last surviving who commenced business before the present century. She died at her residence in Franklin Place, December 9, 1856, "a lady who will be greatly missed for long-continued charities and uniform benevolence." (Gen. Reg.) "She was a very intelligent old lady of the old school."

(3) SAMUEL NORTON⁷.

(4) ANDREWS NORTON⁷: was a graduate of Harvard College in 1804 and for many years distinguished for great literary attainments. He was one of the most eminent scholars and theologians of the Unitarian denomination. He was a cleryman in Salem for several years, and afterwards Divinity professor at Harvard College. He was father of the present *Charles Eliot Norton*, professor of Fine Arts at Harvard.

1122. JOSEPH ANDREWS⁶, born Aug 5, 1757; died Nov. 2, 1777. At the age of nineteen he entered the Revolutionary Army. On one occasion he, with two other young men about his own age, got possession of a piece of artillery and drew it to an eminence commanding the road upon which a considerable body of Hessians were marching to join the main army of the enemy. They prevented tem from doing do by this skilful maneuver. Gen. Washington, in his supervision of the action of the day, noticed the service of the young men, and directed the commanding officer of the regiment to send for them, and, by conversation, to

ascertain what situations they were capable of filling, and to give to each such a commission as was suited to his capacity. A lieutenant's commission was given to each. At the battle of Brandywine, the captain of the company to which Lieutenant Andrews belonged was killed early in the action, and he took command. He was soon wounded and carried off the field, and died shortly after of his wounds. Gen. Lafayette, on his last visit to this country, said to Rev. John Andrews of Newburyport, that he remember his brother Joseph perfectly, and intended to have called on him during his illness, but his wounds were not healed sufficiently to enable him to go out before he heard of his death.

Jotham Loring of Hingham, son of Thomas and Sarah (Hersey) Loring. Col. Loring was born April 30, 1740, and died September 28, 1820. She died November 14, 1776.

Col. Jotham Loring removed to Duxbury, and married, secondly Lucia, daughter of Deacon Benjamin Wadsworth, and had children, ----- one being named Wadsworth. He was an active patriot in the Revolution.

366. JOHN RICHMOND⁵ (Sylvester⁴, Silvester³, Edward², John¹) was born in Dighton, Mass., March 12, 1738-9. He married, July 23, 1769, Margaret Lee of Swansey, who was born in Swansey, February 1, 1750, and died February 16, 1782. He married, secondly, Mrs. ----- Atwood. He died in Providence, May 5, 1804.

He entered college, but did not graduate, on account of "sowing too many wild oats." He was a captain in the French Wars, although very young. He was at the taking of Quebec, and stood by the side of Gen. Wolfe when he fell. John Richmond Decker, a great grandson of John⁵, has a "Gazetteer of the World" printed about 1772. On the margin of the page where an account is given of the taking of Quebec, the following is written: "I was at y^e taking of Quebec by Gen. Wolfe, as a brave Commander indeed as ever came from old England. (signed) John Richmond."

He was a gentleman of education, and excellent linguist; he had great kindness of heart, and in his office as High Sheriff he paid debt after debt rather than distress the debtor, until his generosity ruined him and he died poor.

367. NATHANIEL RICHMOND⁵ (Sylvester⁴, Silvester³, Edward², John¹) was born in Dighton, Mass., March 12, 1739. He married, first (banns published September 28, 1765), Anna Brownell, daughter of Jonathan and Elizabeth (Richmond) Brownell of Dartmouth, who was born February 2, 1743, and died January 4, 1791. He married, secondly (banns published July 14, 1792), Rebecca Shaw, daughter of David Simmons of Dighton. He died January 1, 1808.

He resided in Westport, Mass., from 1765-1791. He was a graduate of Harvard College in 1764, a classmate of Gov. Strong, and possessed superior talents, united with unusual refinement of manners. He was a gentleman of the old school and of the day. He was a farmer, and was Sheriff in Dighton and Westport. After his marriage he removed to Westport, Mass., thence to New York State in 1795.

He was in the battle of Bunker Hill, and was also Sheriff of Bristol County during the time of the Revolution, and as such paid his respects to the commander of the French fleet, Count de Grasse, when he entered Newport Harbor during the war. His first wife is said to have possessed great excellence of character.

In Barry’s History of Hanover, David Jacob⁵, is mentioned thus: “he was an extensive landholder and surveyor, a selectman, and several years (1776-7-8) a member of the Committee of Safety in the Revolution; Representative to the General Court two years. At the time of the Revolution he kept a public house.”

David Jacobs⁶, was the father of Mrs. Sumner, mother of Hon. Charles Sumner.

Three daughters of Perez⁴, and Deborah (Loring) Richmond, viz.: Hannah, Deborah and Elizabeth, married three brothers of the Jacobs family of Scituate, Mass. They were large farmers and mill-owners, and lived within sight of each other. They were very industrious, successful and highly respectable. This Jacobs family descended from English gentry. Nicholas Jacobs came from Hingham, England, to Hingham Mass., in 1633. They have a very attractive coat of arms. David, grandson of Nicholas, went in 1688 from Hingham to Scituate. We was very well educated, and a leading man there. His sons Joshua and Dr. Joseph settled in Scituate, and their lands are owned by their descendants. Davis Jacobs, who married Hannah Richmond,

was known as “Landlord Jacobs,” and his brothers as “Masters.” They had slaves and dependents, and their old homestead was standing in 1860. (See Barry’s History of Hanover for details.)

John Cushing was son of John and Elizabeth (Holmes) Cushing; and he son of John and Deborah (Loring) Cushing; and he son of John and Sarah (Hawkes) Cushing; he was the youngest son of Mathew and Nazareth (Pitcher) Cushing; and he was the son of Peter Cushing of Norfolk, England.

ANCESTORS OF ELIZABETH CUSHING.

Nazareth Pitcher, the daughter of Henry Pitcher, who was baptized October 30, 1585, was married to Mathew Cushing, the son of Peter Cushing, of Norfolk, England. The said Mathew, and Nazareth, his wife, with their children, viz., Daniel, their eldest son, Jeremiah, Mathew, Deborah, their only daughter, and John¹, their youngest son, came all together in one ship to New England, arriving in Boston August 10, 1638. The name of the ship was the “Diligent,” of Ipswich, of three hundred and fifty tons burthen; the master was John Martin of Ipswich. Mathew, with his children, settled in Hingham, Mass., and died September 30, 1660, aged about seventy-two years. His wife Nazareth, died January 6, 1681, in the ninety-sixth year of her age.

The following extracts are taken from a small memorandum book of John Cushing¹ kept during his voyage over with his father in 1638, he being then about eleven years old: --
“I came from London to Gravesend 23^d April, 1638. Upon the 26th of April we set sail from Gravesend. Upon the 1st of May we came to the *Downs* and set sail from thence the 2^d day of May. Upon the 4th day of May we lost sight of land.”
