**PRINCIPLE RESOURCES IN THIS CENTER**

***Family Search-2001 Edition***

**International Genealogical Index (IGI)** -1993 Edition with 2000 Addendum -This collection lists names of individuals, arranged by country and state, and contains births, christenings, and marriages. In addition, it contains temple ordinance dates.

**Ancestral File -1998 Edition** -Family History Data assembled primarily by members of the LDS church.

**Social Security Death Index**- 2000 Edition -Deaths from 1937 to 2000.

**Military Death Records** -1997 Edition -Korean and Vietnam War Deaths.

**Scottish Church Records** -Contains apx. 10 million names extracted from the Scottish church records from the late 1500's to 1854.

**Temple Ready** -Prepares your family file for temple ordinances against the latest edition of the IGI.

**Family History Library Catalog (FHLC) 1998 Edition** -Lists all the holdings of the Family History Library in Salt Lake City. You may obtain approximately 95% of this vast store of information by rental of microfilm that may be used here in our center.

***Vital Records Indexes***

**North American** -Contains more than 4.6 million records from events in the United States & Canada from about 1700 to 1888.

**British** - Contains more than 4.7 million records from England, Wales, Scotland and Ireland from 1500 to 1888.

**Western Europe** -Contains 12.5 million records from Western European countries. It is divided into six regions.

**Mexico** -Contains 2 million birth, christening and marriage records from selected localities. Covers the period 1659 to 1905.

**Australian** -Contains 4.5 million christening, birth and marriage records from across Australia during the period 1788 to 1905.

**Scandinavian**- Contains 3 million christening, birth and marriage records from across Denmark, Sweden and Norway.

***Census Records***

**British 1851** -Contains 1.5 million census records of Devon, Norfolk and Warwick counties.

**British 1881** -Contains 30 million census records from England, Wales, Scotland, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man.

**United States 1880** -Contains 50 million census records organized into family units with the added feature of showing neighbors.

### ***Other Records***

***Mormon Immigration Index*** -Contains 93,000 records of immigrants who traveled to the United States between 1840 and 1890.

***Pedigree Resource File*** -A compilation of over 30 million names submitted by individuals through Family Search Internet Genealogy Service. The record will continue to grow as individuals submit their records.

***Freedman's Bank Records*** -Freedman's Bank was created to assist newly freed slaves during and after the Civil War. The record covers the period of 1864 -1871 and contains 480,000 names of African American descent.

***Family History Source Guide*** -This is an electronic collection of more than 150 research outlines. It is designed for those who have basic information about their ancestors and now need to be guided to original sources. ***Micro Fiche Collection*** -Thousands of microfiche records ordered by patrons and kept at the Family History Center indefinitely. They represent books, records and histories from across the world.

***Family History Library Catalog/Windows Version*** -The newest version of the catalog of all the holdings in the Salt Lake City Library. You may obtain approximately 95% of this vast store of information by rental of microfilm that may be used here in our center.

***Computer Hardware*** -3 computer stations with 17" monitors, high-speed printers and access to all FHC computer resources.

***Temple Ready*** -Windows Version -The most up-to-date software used to process names prior to taking them to the Temple.

***Personal Ancestral File (P AF) 2.1 -5. 0*** -Genealogical management programs available in English, Spanish, French, German & Portuguese.

***Books, Books, Books*** -An ever growing collection of "How To Do" research books from both the United States and other countries

***Microfilm/Microfiche Readers*** -8 microfilm and 3 microfiche readers-

***Microfilm/Microfiche Copier*** -A copy machine that reproduces copies of microfilm/fiche records.
